3. Alternatively go to <https://internationaloliveawardsaustralia.com.au> and complete your online entry. Once online entry and payment is completed, you will receive a confirmation email.
4. Clearly mark each entry (jar/tin/pouch) with the 4-digit identification code used on this entry form. Photographs of the front label will occur so place code sticker at the back of packaging.
