- 2. Download and complete this form including the declaration on this page. Include form with your oil entries or scan and email to <a href="mailto:aioa@australianolives.com.au">aioa@australianolives.com.au</a>. The AOA will email you a receipt for your payment. A \$20 handling fee will be incurred for all paper entries (not online).
- 3. Alternatively go to <a href="https://internationaloliveawardsaustralia.com.au">https://internationaloliveawardsaustralia.com.au</a> and complete your online entry. Once online entry and payment is completed, you will receive a confirmation email.
- 4. Clearly mark **each** container (jar/tin/pouch) with the 4-digit Exhibit ID Code used on this entry form. Use a separate code for each different type of table olive entry. The front label will be photographed so place code sticker at the back of packaging. Required samples volume minimum of 1.5 kg of olives per entry, packaged in a minimum of at least three separate containers
- 5. Send your adequately packed and labelled entry/s (with 4-digit Exhibit ID Code) with a copy of your entry details (online entry receipt or hard copy entry form) and payment receipt to: AIOA Head Steward, Trudie Michels, C/o 8 Alexander Avenue, Cumberland Park SA 5041 Australia. Entries must be received by Friday 1st September 2023.
- 6. Once, your entries(s) and payments have been received they are officially part of the competition. If your entry samples are not received prior to the 1st September 2023, the entry will not be included in the judging process.
